**Re: Donations to the Charles F. Porter, Jr. Trust**

Dear Potential Donors,

If you are reading this letter, there is a high likelihood that your life, or that of someone close to you, has been personally touched by the joyous and vibrant love that is Charles F. Porter, Jr. For the past thirty-one years, Charles has approached his life with wide-eyed enthusiasm. His boundless devotion to friendship, infectious laughter, and knack for making others feel better about themselves after being in his presence has made Charles a loved member of countless families.

On April 21, 2010, Charles was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma. The disease has progressed to Stage IV, with bone involvement complicating the matter. As you know, medical fees for prescriptions, treatments, nutrition and specialty items can grow to astronomical amounts. Charles and his family greatly appreciate your willingness to help offset costs due to the unfortunate fact that he is dealing with his disease without health insurance.

In an attempt to best assist Charles in easing his daily expenses, we formed the Charles F. Porter, Jr. Trust (the "Trust") for his benefit (as a charity cannot benefit a single individual, that was not an option). The Trust is designed to assist Charles with his continued health, support, and maintenance needs in these difficult times. As Trustee, I will be responsible for assisting Charles by using the Trust assets for his benefit. I am happy to provide trust documentation upon request.

We are asking for your help in one or more of the following ways:

1. Make a donation directly to the Charles F. Porter, Jr. Trust. Unfortunately, any payments to Charles' Trust ***cannot be charitable donations***. If you decide to donate directly to the Trust, your donation will be considered a gift, to which your federal annual exclusion will not apply (i.e., each year, each person may gift up to \$13,000 to an unlimited number of individuals without using their lifetime gift tax exemption). Therefore, any gift will be ***required to be reported on a federal gift tax return*** (IRS Form 709), which will be due on April 15 of the year following the gift to the Trust.
2. Make a donation directly to William Hill, to be used for Charles' benefit. Although this is a gift and not a charitable donation, unless your gift totals more than \$13,000, there will be no need to file a gift tax return. All donations made in this fashion will be gifted to the Trust.
3. Organize or host a fund-raiser. If you have a fund-raiser idea and the capacity to facilitate its success or host the function, please contact "Team Porter" at [fight4cp@gmail.com](mailto:fight4cp@gmail.com).


To make a donation:
